

The City of Mandeville's 2017 Winter on the Water Art Contest



Entry Criteria:

- All artwork should be original and hand-drawn.
- Any mediums (crayon, marker, ink, watercolors) are acceptable, and any number of colors may be used in the design. Stick-on letters, glitter, or stickers are not permitted, nor may the artwork contain copyrighted images and/or slogans.
- Artwork must be drawn within the boxed area on the attached 8" x 14" entry form and must be vertical (portrait). Be careful to keep the design within the boxed area.
- This year's theme is "**Holiday Bells in Mandeville**". How does your family celebrate with bells during the holiday season in Mandeville? How does your school or your neighborhood decorate with bells? Your artwork can portray any of the seasonal bells in yards, on houses, on businesses, and along streets and roadways during the holiday season.
- The deadline for receipt of your artwork is *October 4, 2017*. Entries may be dropped off at the Mandeville Spitzfaden Community Center at 3090 East Causeway Approach, Mandeville, LA 70448, or mailed to Mandeville's Art Contest, 675 Lafitte Street, Mandeville, LA 70448. **Please Do Not Fold Artwork.**
- All artwork must include the artist's name (please print), grade, teacher's name, and name of school.
- The finalists will be notified by October 20, 2017 and recognized at the November City Council Meeting.
- The winning entries will be reproduced as the 2017 Winter on the Water Banners to be displayed along Girod Street. Finalists will also be featured in an art exhibit to be shown at City Hall during the month of December.
